## 1 Introduction

echo(1) is a Unix command line tool, which writes its command line arguments to the standard output. This is a simple acceptance test suite for the `/bin/echo` implementation.

## 2 No arguments

Run `/bin/echo` without arguments.

*when* user runs echo without arguments  
*then* exit code is 0  
*and* standard output contains a newline  
*and* standard error is empty

## 3 Hello, world

This scenario runs `/bin/echo` to produce the output “hello, world”.

*when* user runs echo with arguments *hello, world*  
*then* exit code is 0  
*and* standard output contains “*hello, world*”  
*and* standard error is empty
